February I was back to Mission Adventures. About 9 months out of the year my main focus is on Mission Adventures. I am sure you are sick of hearing about this ministry!! In March & April we saw about 500 young people of all walks of life come through the MA ministry. During the month of April our sister location held their 1st ever DTS and through the prompting of God and the generous support of you guys I was able to provide one of the students with financial assistance to complete this school. April also saw YWAM SDB's 1st ever secondary school, the School of Worship. May was pretty quiet with more planning

for the summer. June - August was extremely busy as we had over 500 youth again for MA. I was also in charge of the 40 or so staff it took to run this amazing ministry. It was definitely a stretching period for me as things seemed to go wrong at every turn. But God is faithful. I again had the privilege of being able to help with financial aid so 20 mexican

youth could come through our ministry and get a heart for missions. September - December has been filled with the Biblical Core Course. The BCC is another YWAM secondary school focusing on the Inductive Bible Study method of learning the Bible. This school has been a HUGE blessing to me and has taught me to look at each verse in context to learn its true meaning for me and how I can apply it. God also blessed

me with the necessary finances through a VERY generous gift of obedience. I have learned so much through the various ministries that I have been apart of this year. God has revealed himself to me over and over again of how faithful, gracious, merciful and just He really is. WOW!

MA: Spring Break March & April sees hundreds of students come through our base for MA. Hope all the planning & prep work out.


